

**2014 Chateau Sixtine Chateauneuf du Pape**

The 2014s were all tasted out of bottle and the 2014 Châteauneuf du Pape Château Sixtine is a terrific success in the vintage; it has plenty of fruit, medium to full-bodied richness, fine tannin and downright classy notes of blackberries, currants, garrigue and toasted spices. Made from 50% Grenache and 25% each of Syrah and Mourvèdre, drink it through 2024.

Brilliant ruby-red. Vibrant aromas of blackberry, licorice, *garrigue* and incense are lifted by a smoky mineral topnote. Gently sweet and expansive in the mouth, offering ripe cherry and dark berry flavors that become livelier and spicier with air. Shows excellent clarity on the long, penetrating finish, which is framed by smooth tannins.

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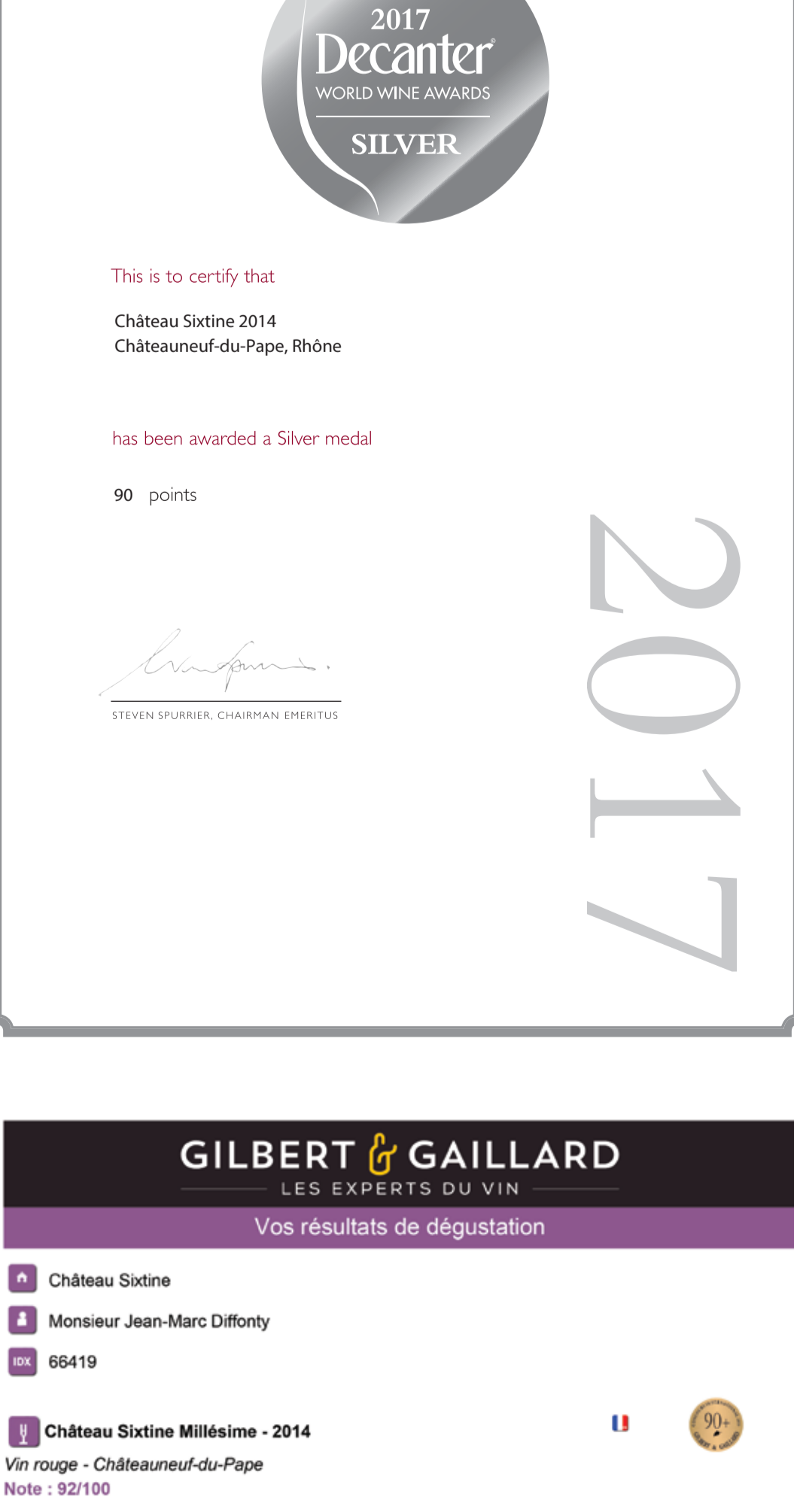
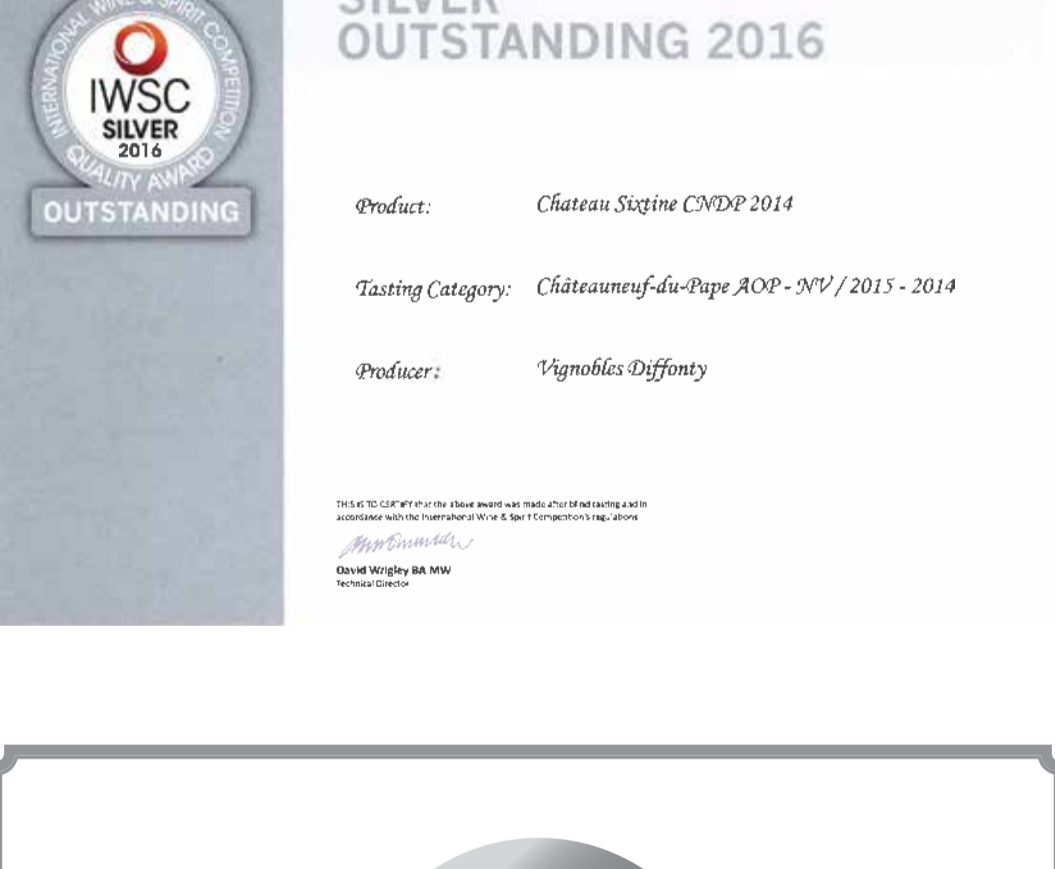

50% Grenache, 25% Syrah, 25% Mourvèdre, FRW £258.00 (2011)

Deep, dark, powerful nose – melted liquorice. Medium-bodied, intense fruit and firm structure to back it up – the tannins are muscular and juicy, not dry. A proper Châteauneuf with balls, juicy fruit, power, and all backed up by keen acid. Long finish. A success in this vintage. 2016-2024
