While previous years were entirely Roussanne, the 2016 Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc incorporates 5% Clairette, presumably to help freshen it. This is a full-bodied, creamytextured white, with honey and tangerine sorbet notes and a long briny finish. It should drink well for 5-6 years.

This cuvée is mostly Roussanne (there's 5% Clairette) and was brought up in a mix of older barrels and stainless steel.
